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Background

Community Council Selected Priorities (18%): Tlingit & Haida will engage Community Councils on community-specific interventions consistent with the act. Community Councils will be able to direct community-specific interventions that are responsive and timely. A process will be created where Community Councils can make recommendations consistent with the ARPA priorities for approval by the Executive Council and operationalized by Tlingit & Haida staff. We expect audits with this Act to be similar to the CARES Act and must meet the stringent legal requirements.

Program Administration (1%): Tlingit & Haida anticipates the need to hire additional staff to assist in the implementation of Community Council priorities to carry out the Act.

ANCHORAGE FUNDS

\$3,245,012. The ARPA funds are available until December 31, 2024 and offer support for our communities to remain diligent in the fight against COVID-19 and work towards recovery from the pandemic's impacts. The designated ARPA funds will be administered by Tlingit & Haida with the guidance of Community Councils who identify projects and expenditures that address the local needs of tribal citizens.
